

# Turkey Trot hosting unique ‘Callmakers’ Summit’

## Aug. 24 event will bring together some of nation’s top callmakers

Candor, N.Y. — Some of the nation’s top turkey callmakers – and callers – will gather here next month at Turkey Trot Acres for the second annual Northeast Callmakers’ Summit.

The event will be held Friday, Aug. 24, beginning at 2 p.m. at Turkey Trot, located at 188 Tubbs Hill Road in Candor (Tioga County).

Among the callmakers lined up for the event are NWTF Grand National friction calling champion Pat Strawser, Pennsylvania callmaker Scott Basehore, award-winning New York box callmaker Scott Witter,

Jeff McKamey (Twisting Creek Calls), Marlin Watkins of Ohio, Jimmy Schaffer (Oak Ridge Calls) of New Jersey, Ed Terefencko (E.T. Custom Turkey Calls), Michael Lapp, Paul Platz, and multiple NWTF Grand National and world turkey calling champion Matt Van Cise (High Class Calls).

Attendees will have the opportunity to purchase calls and talk

turkey hunting with the callmakers and callers, and food will be available all day.

There are also plans in the works to hold a “deep woods” turkey calling contest where competitors do their calling in a turkey hunting setting.

“I’m really excited about the calling contest,” said Turkey Trot owner Pete Clare. “We’ve been talking about doing a contest like

this – in a woods setting – for 30 years.”
